Students Return to School with Excitement and Enthusiasm

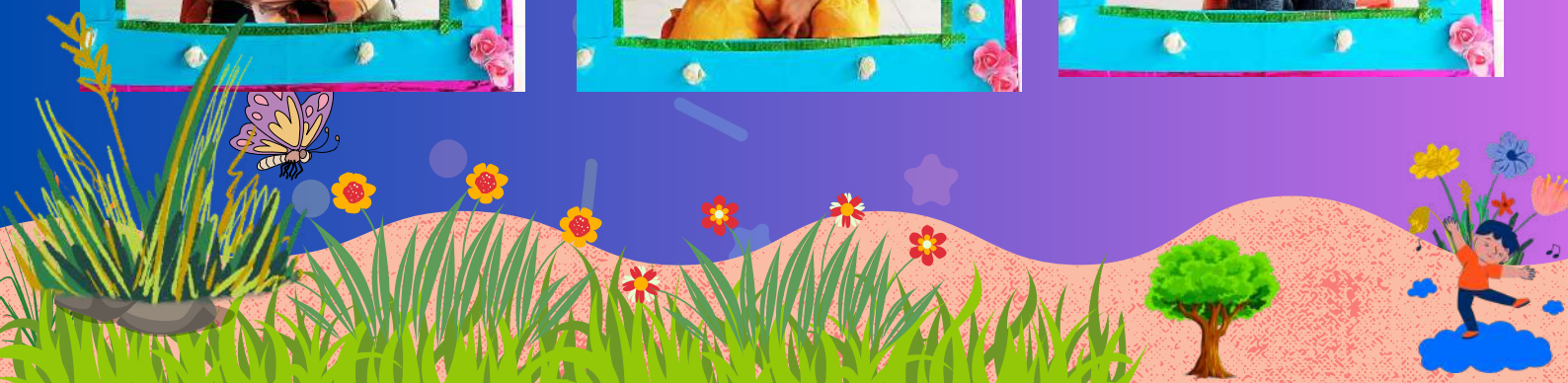
The beginning of a new academic year at Sri Bhagwan mahaveer School, as students, teachers, and staff gathered to celebrate the annual "Back to School" event.
